Rebuilding the Lives
of Katrina Survivors,
Family by Family

Since August 2006, the St. Bernard Project (SBP) has rebuilt more than 200 homes in St. Bernard Parish, with the help of more than 10,000 volunteers from around the world. Currently, SBP has more than 50 homes under some phase of construction and an extensive waiting list of families who've been approved for their rebuilding services. The Project also receives five to ten new applications for assistance each week. The need is still great, and the time to act is now.



The St. Bernard Project's Rebuilding Program rebuilds homes for senior citizens, people with disabilities and families with children who can not afford to have their homes rebuilt by contractors. For clients who can afford supplies, the St. Bernard Project provides supervised volunteer labor. For clients who can not afford supplies, the St. Bernard Project buys the supplies and provides the labor.

A typical rebuild project takes approximately 12 weeks and costs approximately \$15,000 worth of building supplies to complete. Specifically, during the rebuilding process SBP:

- Assigns a skilled construction manager to oversee all phases of rebuilding.
- Purchases and delivers all building materials necessary to rebuild the client's home.
- Places a skilled site supervisor in each client's home to supervise the volunteers and serve as the direct point of contact for each client.
- Assigns a staff member (often a former client) to check in regularly with client during the rebuilding process.
